Something from outside (or if you have multiple centers, multiple elements that have been growing in accretion, one of them) comes crashing into your growing mass, ripping part of it away, leaving marks. Of what is ripped away, some gets lost in space, the rest coheres into its own object, nearby, illuminating, separate, influencing.

So this prompt has something to do with breaking up what has been knit together, with re-sorting the material you have into two bodies, with particular respect to leaving open a pull between those two resulting bodies, separated but linked.
